Day 204 | Tuesday | October 13 | Philemon 1 | A letter from Paul and Timothy to Philemon our dear friend and co-worker, to Apphia our sister, to Archippus our fellow-soldier, and to the church in your house; Paul pledges for Onesimus, a slave, who Paul loves as a father and asks Philemon, his master to take him back and charge Paul for any expenses.

Day 205 | Wednesday | October 14 | <u>Hebrews 1</u> | In the past God spoke in many ways through many people, but now God speaks through Jesus the Christ; Jesus the Son is ahead of all things even angels.

Day 206 | Thursday | October 15 | Hebrews 2 | Don't fall away from what you have learned and heard; Jesus suffered and doing this while being very human.

Day 207 | Friday | October 16 | Hebrews 3 | Therefore, brothers and sisters, holy partners in a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, ...; Compared to Moses; take care that none of you may have evil or enter into unbelief.
